Finished measurements

Sizes	Width	Length
Cowl	6¾ in/ 17 cm	approx 35½ in/ 90 cm

Yarn

Misti Alpaca Solid Chunky (100% Baby Alpaca, 100 g = approx 109 yards, shown in AZ3964 Monaco Blue and Hand Paint Chunky CP58 Sky Gray) 1 hank

Needles

US 11 (8 mm) straight needles, or size necessary to obtain gauge
US L/11/8mm crochet hook

Notions

Yarn Needle

Gauge/Tension

11 sts = 10 cm or 4 in in pattern st on size US 8 (5 mm) needles; row gauge isn't essential

To Knit:

Cast on 19 sts and work moss st pattern as follows:

Row 1: [k1, p1] across

Row 2: [p1, k1] across

When work meas approx 5 inches divide at center with 10 sts at one side and 9 sts on the other. Join another ball of yarn and continue each side

separately for approx 3 inches. Returning to working with one ball across all stitches, continue until 4½ yards of yarn are left. Bind off, but do not cut yarn.

Crocheted edge:

Insert hook in first st to work along short edge and pull up a loop, ch 2. [Yo, insert hook in next st and pull up a long loop] twice (5 loops on hook), yo, and pull through all loops, sk 1 st, sl st in next st, rep from * across ending with sl st in last st. Fasten off.

Join yarn with sl st in first st on other edge, ch 2, repeat across this edge as above.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.

To wear, insert long end through keyhole.

Abbreviations

ch = chain
k = knit
p = purl
sl st = slip stitch (crochet)
yo = yarn over
