Pattern 3023

Finished measurements

Sizes	Depth	Length at bottom edge
Cowl	8 in/ 20 cm	approx 40 in/ 100 cm

Yarn

Misti Alpaca Chunky (100% Baby Alpaca, 100 g = approx 109 yards, shown in Solid 0837 Misted Yellow and Handpaint CP51 Treasure) 1 hank

Needles

US 11 (8 mm) straight needles, or size necessary to obtain gauge
Size L/11/8mm crochet hook

Notions

Yarn Needle

1 1/2in decorative button

1 backing button

Gauge/Tension

12 sts = 10 cm or 4 in in garter st on size US 8 (5 mm) needles; row gauge isn't essential

To Knit:

Cast on 24 sts and work as follows:

**K 4 rows.

Next Row: [K1, yo] 12 times, k12.

Next row: Knit all sts, dropping all yo as you come to them.**

Rep from ** until 5 yards of yarn remains. Bind off.

Crocheted Flower

Ch4, sl st in first ch to form ring, [ch 5, sl st in ring] 5 times, flip work, [ch 6, sl st in ring around prev sl st] 5 times. Fasten off.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.

Sew flower where dropped yarn overs form a natural crease on one end of cowl using the decorative button on the front and the backing button on the back. Use a space in the fabric to hold the backing button to close the cowl front.

Abbreviations

ch = chain
k = knit
p = purl
sl st = slip stitch (crochet)
yo = yarn over
