Skill level: easiest -- the yarn does all the work for you

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Sizes	One Hank
Lenght	48in
	122cm
Width	5in
	13cm

Yarn

Misti Alpaca Hand Paint Super Chunky (50% baby alpaca/ 50% fine merino, 100 g = approx. 55 yards/ 50 meters)

1 hank

Needles

U.S. 15 (10 mm)

To Knit

CO 10 stitches. Knit 2 rows. Begin stitch pattern:

Row 1: Knit, wrapping each stitch three times. Row 2: Knit loosely, especially first stitch, dropping the extra wraps for each stitch to create the elongated stitches.

Row 3: Knit

Note: after each Row 3, pull scarf stitches lengthwise to tighten and set stitches of previous repeat.

Repeat 3-row stitch pattern 19 times for 1 hank of Super Chunky.

When you have at least 4 feet/ 1.25 meters of yarn remaining, knit 2 rows. BO.

Finishing:

Weave in ends. To block, dampen scarf and stretch out to 48 in/ 122 cm to dry, pinning down only narrow ends.



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
