

Caterpillar Scarf or Stole

Skill level: Beginners

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

With	10 in
	25.5 cm
Length	80 in
	203 cm

Yarn

Misti Alpaca Hand Paint Super Chunky (50% baby alpaca/ 50% wool, 100 gr = 55 yards)

7 hanks

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Needles

U.S. 13 (9 mm)

or correct needle size to obtain gauge

Gauge/Tension

10 stitches and 13 rows = 4 in/ 10 cm in pattern stitch

To knit

Using Hand Paint Super Chunky, CO 25 sts.

Row 1 and 2: p all sts Row 3: p2, k21, p2 Row 4: p all sts

Repeat Rows 3 and 4 until scarf measures 79 inches/ 200 cm. Knit Rows 1 and 2. BO.

Fringe

Cut a piece of cardboard 6 inches/ 15 cm long. Using Super Chunky solid color, wrap yarn around cardboard. Cut yarn at one end, making 12 inch/ 30 cm pieces.

Fold each 12 inch/ 30 mm length of yarn in half and insert folded end through scarf edges (you might find a large crochet hook helpful here), creating a loop. Pass the two ends of the folded piece through the loop and pull tightly, which will knot the fringe. Repeat, placing fringe close together around scarf.
