

# Jeweled Basket Scarf

Free Pattern 2047 Designed by Randi Sunde Skill level: advanced beginner



Width: approx 7.5 in or 18 cm

Length: approx 34 in or 85 cm

#### Yarn

Misti Alpaca **Best of Nature Chunky** (100% Baby Alpaca, All Natural Dyes, Hand Paint, 100 g = 109 yds, shown in BN05 Lilac, can be knit in any Misti Alpaca Chunky weight yarns!)

### 1 hank

#### Needles

US 10 or 10.5 = 6 or 7 mm

#### **Notions**

11 large beads in matching color + small beads for stoppers.

# Gauge/Tension

Approx 13-14 sts pattern = 4 in in or 10 cm width.



#### To knit

CO 23 sts. K 1 row, beg pattern as follows:

Row 1: k2 (= edge sts), p3, [k1, p5], rep [] once more, k1, p3, k2 (= edge sts). Row 2: k2, p3tog, yo, k3 sts in next st (= k1,yo,k1), yo, [p5tog, yo, k3 sts in next st, yo], rep once more, p3tog, k2 (= edge sts)

Row 3 and 5: k2, k1, [p5, k1], rep [] once more, p5, k1, k2

Row 4: k2, p1, k5, [p1, k5], rep [ ] once more, p1, k2

Row 6: k1, k2 sts in 1 st (= k1, p1 tbl), yo, p5tog, [yo, k3 sts in 1 st, yo, p5tog], yo, k2 sts in 1 st, k2.

Row 7: k2, p3, [k1, p5], rep [] once more, k1, p3, k2

Row 8: k2, k3, [p1, k5], rep [ ] once more, p1, k3, k2.

Rep pattern for entire scarf ending after row 4 or 7.

Work as long as yarn allows, leaving small amount for finishing and cord. K 1 row, Cast off.

Attach beads at each ends using the small bead as stopper.

## Cord

Cast on 3 sts, [k 1 row, slide sts to other end of ndl, pull yarn to tighten], rep [] as until all yarn is used.

Note: do not turn work. Tie ends of cord to a ring large enough for both ends of scarf to pass.

Fasten a bead at each end.

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
inc = increase
k = knit

k3tog = knit 3 together

p = purl

p3tog =purl 3 together p5tog =purl 5 together rem = remain/remaining

rep = repeat RS = right side

st/sts= stitch/ stitches

tbl =through the back loop



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
