Finished measurements

Sizes	Depth	Length at bottom edge
Cowl	8¼ in/ 21 cm	approx 32 in/ 80 cm

Yarn

Misti Alpaca Chunky (100% Baby Alpaca, 100 g = approx 109 yards, shown in solid 3207 Mauve Mist, Tonos TTC40 Salmon and HandPaint CP65 Sunset Ridge) 1 hank

Needles

US 11 (8 mm) straight needles, or size necessary to obtain gauge
Size L/11/8mm crochet hook

Notions

Yarn Needle
1 1/2in decorative button
1 backing button

Gauge/Tension

11 sts = 11 cm or 4¼ in in pattern on size US 8 (5 mm) needles; row gauge isn't essential

Note: Knit the last stitch of every row and slip the first stitch of every row purlwise for edge stitches.

To Knit:

Cast on 23 sts and work as follows:

Rows 1 & 2: Knit.

Row 3: Sl 1, [yo, k2tog] across.

Rows 4 & 5: Knit.

Row 6 (RS): Sl 1, [k2, p1, k1] 5 times, k2.

Row 7: Sl 1, p1, [k3, p1] t times, k1.

Rows 8-21: Rep rows 6 & 7.

Rep rows 1-21 until 5 yards of yarn remain.

Rep rows 1-5. Bind off.

Finishing

Sew short ends together with 1 half-twist in the cowl. Weave in ends.



Abbreviations

ch = chain
k = knit
p = purl
k2tog = knit 2 together
sl = slip
