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# Lattice Knit & Crochet Scarf

Free Pattern 2046

Skill level: advanced beginner



## Finished Measurements

Width middle section: approx 4.5 in or 11 cm

Length: approx 36.5 in or 92 cm

## Yarn

Misti Alpaca **Hand Paint Chunky** (100% Baby Alpaca Hand Paint, 100 g = 109 yds, shown in CP24 Magic Flute, can be knit in any Misti Alpaca Chunky weight yarns!)

## 1 hank

## Needles

US 10.5 = 7 mm

Crochet hook: US J or 10 / 6 or 7 mm

## Notions

1 button or bead (optional) for centre of rose

pin to secure rose (optional)

## Gauge/Tension

Approx 13-14 sts pattern = 10 cm or 4 in in width.

## To knit

CO 16 sts. Next row = RS: \*\*sl 1 (= edge st), [k3, p3], rep [ ] in the row, end with k1. On WS: work sts as they appear. Edge sts: sl at beg of row, k at end of row. Work rib for approx 6 cm (last row WS).

Next row: sl 1, [p3, k3], rep [ ] in the row, WS: work sts as they appear. Rep rib pattern from \*\* until work meas approx 37 cm (ending with a full rib rep).

Divide remaining yarn in approx 2 equal amounts, one for each crochet section. Leave small amount for "rose".

Work crocheted sections as follows:

Row 1: Fasten yarn at one corner, [ch4, skip 1 st, 1 sc in next st], rep [ ].

Row 2: 1 dc in last sc, ch2, [1 sc in ch-loop, ch4], rep [ ], end with ch2, 1 dc in edge sc.

Row 3: [ch4, 1 sc in ch4-loop], rep [ ], end with 1 sc in end st.

Rep row 2 + 3 for approx 11 - 12 rows, Cont ch-loops in the same manner but now with ch5 instead of ch4.

Last row: Beg as usual, [ch5, 1sl st in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook (= 1 picot), ch2, 1 sc in next ch5-loop], rep [ ] to end of row.

## Rose

With crochet hook ch6, then 1 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch, 1 hdc in next ch, 2 dc in each rem ch. With rem yarn work ch-loops below outer edge on previous row. Form to a rose. Fasten button or bead in a matching color at centre of rose. Attach a pin at centre under the rose and use for closing or decoration.

BO = bind off  
ch = chain (using crochet hook)  
CO = cast on  
dc = double crochet  
inc = increase  
k = knit  
meas = measures  
rem = remain/remaining  
rep = repeat  
RS =right side  
sl 1 =slip one stitch  
sc =single crochet  
st/sts= stitch/ stitches



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
