One size

Finished Measurements

Width: approx 8.5in/21.5 cm

Length: approx 34.5in/87.5 cm

Yarn

Misti Alpaca Handpaint Chunky (100% baby alpaca, 100 g = approx 109 yards/100 meters), shown in color Carmen CP22

2 hanks

Needles

U.S. 10 (6 mm) needles, or size necessary to obtain gauge

U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook

Tapestry needle

Notions

Large coat hook and eye closure

Three small buttons (optional)

Gauge

12 sts and 17 rows = 4in/10 cm in pattern

Basket Stitch (multiple of 6 sts +4)

Rows 1 and all other RS rows: Slip 1 wyb, knit to end.

Rows 2 (WS): Slip 1 wyf, purl to last st, k1.

Rows 4 and 6: Slip 1 wyf, p2, *k4, p2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 8: Rep Row 2.

Rows 10 and 12: Slip 1 wyf, k3, *p2, k4; rep from * to to end.

Rep Rows 1 - 12 for pattern.

Reverse St st (any number of sts)

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Row 2 (RS): Purl.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for pattern.

To knit

CO 28 sts. Work in St st for 4 rows. Work as follows: 3 rows in rev St st, 3 rows in St st, then 3 rows in rev St st.

Beg Basket St and work until scarf measures approx 31.5in/80 cm, end with Row 6 or 10 of pattern. Work next RS row in pattern.

Work 3 rows in rev St st, 3 rows in St st, then 3 rows in rev St st. Work in rev St st for 4 rows. BO all sts.

Roses

Large (make 2)

CO 13 sts, leaving a 12in/30.5 cm tail.

Row 1 (RS): (K1, yo, k1) in each st across = 39 sts. Work even in St st for 2 rows. BO all sts.

Small (make 1)

CO 7 sts, leaving a 12in/30.5 cm tail.

Row 1 (RS): (K1, yo, k1) in each st across = 21 sts. Work even in St st for 1 row. BO all sts.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Do not block.

Thread tail through cast-on edge of rose, gather edge along yarn and wind to form a rose. Knot tail to secure edge. Rep with remaining roses.

Sew roses to one end of scarf (see photo). Use yarn to make French knots in center of each rose or sew small button in center of each.

On WS sew hook from large hook and loop to corner under roses. Loop hook in scarf to wear.

Abbreviations

approx = approximately

beg = begin, beginning

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

in = inch(es)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

rev = reverse

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side

wyb = with yarn in back of work

wyf = with yarn in front of work

yo = yarn over
