Pattern 3012

Finished measurements

Height × Width

5½ × 3⅞ in (14 × 10cm)

Yarn

Misti Alpaca Pima Silk Hand Paint yarn, (83% Pima Cotton & 17% Silk, 100 gr = 327 yards,) CSP11 April Showers × 1 hank.

Hook

Size 3 mm (US C/2 or D/3) hook, or size necessary to obtain gauge

Notions

Tapestry needle

Snap (optional)

60 cm satin ribbon in matching color

Gauge/Tension

11 sc = 2 inches (5 cm)

Instructions

Foundation Rnd: Ch 29, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across to last ch, work 3 sc in last ch, rotate work 180° to continue along opposite side of starting ch, sc in each ch on opposite side of starting ch ending with 2 sc in last st, sl st to first sc to join.

Next Rnd: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, sl st in first ch to join.

Rep last rnd until work measures 3¾"/9.5cm

Cover Flap

Now working in rows.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in next 30 sts, turn.

Rep Row 1 until flap measures 3"/7.5cm. Fasten off.

Next Row: With sl st, join yarn at corner of flap and bag opening with RS facing. Evenly work sc across side of flap, work 3 sc in corner, work sc across long edge of flap, work 3 sc in corner, work sc evenly across side of flap. Fasten off.

Next Row: With sl st, join yarn at same corner as join of prev row, ch 1, sc in same st, *ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook skip 1 sc, 1 sc in next st; rep from * across sts from prev row. Fasten off.

Finishing

Cut ribbon in half and sew one end to cover flap and one end to pouch. Tie a nice bow.

Decorate with a satin bow on cover flap.

Optional: Use snap to close cover flap.

Abbreviations

ch = chain

rep = repeat

RS = right side

rnd/rnds = round/rounds

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

st/sts = stitch/stitches
