Finished measurements

Sizes	Bust Circumference	Length
Vest	36 (39½, 44) in 91.5 (100, 112)cm	18 (19¼, 20½) in 45.5 (49, 52)cm

Yarn

Best of Nature Worsted Hand Painted (100% Baby Alpaca, 100 g = approx 218 yards, shown in BHW10 Everglades) x 3, 4, 5 hanks

Needles

Sizes US 7 & 8 (4.5mm & 5 mm) circular ndles and a pair of size 7 (4.5mm) straight ndles, or size necessary to obtain gauge.

Notions

Stitch Holders
Stitch markers (m)

Gauge/Tension

18 sts x 24 rows in St st on size 8 (5mm) ndles = 4 in (10 cm). SAVE TIME BY CHECKING YOUR GAUGE

Notes

Back and Fronts are worked in one piece from the bottom up. Sleeves are worked separately. All pieces are worked in one piece for yoke.

Body

Lower Edging

With 5mm ndls cast on 162 (178, 198) sts.

Knit 6 rows

Main Body

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: K3, p156 (172, 192), k3.

Rep these 2 rows, ending with RS row, until piece from cast-on edge measures 10½ (11¼, 11¾) inches or 27 (28.5, 30)cm.

Divide for raglan shaping

Next Row: K3, p35 (38, 42), BO 8 (10, 12) sts, k70 (76, 84), BO 8 (10, 12) sts, p35 (38, 42), k3.

Place sts on holders.

Sleeves

Make 2.

With 5mm circular needle, cast on 54 (60, 64) sts.

Knit 4 rows.

Knit in St st until work measures 1¼ inches or 3cm from cast on edge, ending with a RS row.

BO 4 (5, 6) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Place 46 (50, 52) sts on holder.

Yoke

Knit 38 (41, 45) sts of Right Front off of holder, pm, k46 (50, 52) sts from sleeve, pm, k70 (76, 84) Back stitches from holder, pm, k46 (50, 52) sts from sleeve, pm, k38 (41, 45) sts of Left Front from holder—238 (258, 278) sts.

Next Row (WS): K3, purl to last 3 sts, k3.

Decrease Row: Knit to 3 sts before first m, ssk, k2, k2tog, [knit to 3 sts before next m, ssk, k2, k2tog] 3 times, knit rem sts—280 (250, 270) sts.

Next Row (WS): K3, purl to last 3 sts, k3.
Rep last 2 rows 16 (18, 19) additional times—102 (106, 118) sts rem
Continue decrease rows every other row, and purl all WS rows *and at the same time*, BO 6 sts at the beg of next 2 rows, then at beg of following pairs of rows BO 5 sts, then 3 (4, 4) sts, then 3 sts—28 (30, 50) sts.

Size L only

Next Row: BO 2 sts, knit to 3 sts before first m, ssk, k2, k2tog, [knit to 3 sts before next m, ssk, k2, k2tog] 3 times, knit rem sts.

Next Row: BO 2 sts, purl rem sts—34 sts.

All Sizes: Place rem sts on holder.

Collar

Change to 4.5mm circular needle.

With RS facing pick up and knit 19 (20, 22) sts evenly along Right Front neck edge, knit across 28 (30, 34) sts from holder, pick up and knit 19 (20, 22) sts evenly along Left Front neck edge—66 (70, 78) sts.

Row 1 (WS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4 (RS): K6, k2tog, yo, ssk, k rem sts.

Row 5: Purl to yo, (p1, k1) in yo, p7.

Row 6: Knit.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Purl.

Row 9: Knit.

Rep last 3 rows until collar, un-stretched, measures 3½ inches or 8 cm. Place m.
Continue in St st on RS until St st section when folded at marker reaches button hole. Make another button hole to match, then continue in St st until collar when folded at marker reaches inside neckline (without stretching). Without casting off, sew sts to inner neckline loosely.

Pockets

Make 2.

With 4.5mm needles cast on 23 sts.

Row 1: Purl.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: Purl.

Rep last 3 rows twice.

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: knit

Rep last 2 rows until pocket measures 12 cm (with first 9 rows not stretched).

BO all sts.

Finishing

With Pocket edging up, sew pockets to Fronts with outer edge under center of underarm bind off.

Sew underarm seams.

Weave in all ends and block gently.

ssk	= slip 2 sts, k tog through back loop
st/sts	= stitch/stitches
St st	= Stockinette stitch Knit 1 row, purl 1 row
WS	= wrong side
yo	= yarn over
