Pattern 3013

Finished measurements

Sizes	Circumference	Length
Hat (one size fits most)	20 in/ 51 cm	approx 8.5 in/ 21.5 cm
Fingerless Gloves S (M, L)	approx 6.75 (7.5, 8.25) in/ 17 (19, 21) cm	approx 5.75 in/ 14.5 cm

Yarn

Misti Alpaca Best of Nature Worsted (100% Baby Alpaca, 100 g = approx 218 yards, shown in BW03 Napa)
1 (2, 2) hank(s)

Needles

US 8 (5 mm) 16 in/ 40 cm circular and set of 5 double pointed needles, or size necessary to obtain gauge

Notions

Stitch marker

Gauge/Tension

20.5 sts and 24 rnds = 10 cm or 4 in in pattern st on size US 8 (5 mm) needles

To Knit: Hat

With circ ndl, CO 102 sts. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker for beg of rnd.

Rnd 1: Purl.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnds 3-6: Rep rnds 1 and 2 twice more.

Rnd 7: Knit.

Rnd 8: *(K2tog) 3 times, (yo, k1) 5 times, yo, (k2tog) 3 times; rep from * around.

Rnd 9: Purl.

Rnd 10: Knit.

Rnds 11-46: Rep rnds 7-10 nine more times.

Rnd 47: Knit.

Rnd 48: Purl.

Rnds 49 and 50: Rep rnds 47 and 48. BO kwise.

Cord

With 2 dpns, CO 3 sts.

Row 1: K3. Do not turn; slide sts back to right end of ndl and bring yarn across back of work.

Rep row 1, pulling yarn to tighten at the beg of every row, until piece meas approx 19.75 in/ 50 cm, or desired length.

Next row: Sl 1, k2tog, pssso.

Fasten off rem st.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements. Thread cord through each peak at top edge. Tie a knot in each end of cord. Gather top edge of hat and tie in a bow.

Fingerless Gloves

Note: For the smallest size, divide the yarn remaining from the hat into 2 equal size balls, 1 for each glove.

With dpns, CO 34 (38, 42) sts. Divide sts evenly over 4 dpns. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker for beg of rnd.

Rnd 1: Purl.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnds 3 and 4: Rep rnds 1 and 2.

Rnd 5: Knit.

Rnd 6: *(K2tog) 3 (4, 2) times, (yo, k1) 5 (7, 4) times, yo, (k2tog) 3 (4, 3) times; rep from * around.

Rnd 7: Purl.

Rnd 8: Knit.

Rnds 9–32: Rep rnds 5-8 six more times.

Rnd 33: Knit.

Rnd 34: Purl.

Rnds 35 and 36: Rep rnds 33 and 34.

BO kwise.

Make second glove same as first.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements if desired.
