Cozy Neck Warmer

Read Instructions Completely before you start!

Skill Level: Intermediate



Sizes

Finished Measurements:

Length: 27 inches

Width: 4 inches

Materials

*3 skeins Misti Alpaca Lace or 2 skeins Misti Alpaca Worsted (100% Baby Alpaca)

Scarf uses approximately 140 yd (134 mt)

Knitting Needles

*US Size 7 (4.5 mm) Needles

*Double-point needles to hold stitches for loop



Note: I like to mix the lace colors to get my own watercolor choice. In the sample I used two strands Moss (MC-1070) and one of Dark Brown (NT-408). Try your hand at mixing the "paints" and enjoy the comfort of this little pleasure.

Instructions

Cast on 2 stitches. Knit 1 row. Place marker on front to indicate RS. In garter stitch (knitting every row) increase 1 st each side every other row until there are 20 sts on needle. Work 20 rows in garter st.

Knit 2 together across the next row (10 sts remain). Knit back. Work k1, p1 ribbing for 12 rows. On next row increase 10 sts evenly across row. Continue in garter st for 15 inches ending with a WS row.

Split for loop as follows: Divide stitches placing every other st on a double-point needle (or other holder). The sts will be on two needles. Knit each 10 st piece in k1, p1 ribbing for 12 rows. Join by alternately knitting sts from each needle (20 sts).

Continuing in garter st work 20 rows. Decrease 1 st each side every RS row until 2 sts remain. Bind off.
