
SINGLE LACE SHAWL

PATTERN





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Yarn required:

Approx 60 g Misti Alpaca Hand Paint Lace Suggested knitting needles: circular ndls no 3,5 or 4. Change needles if required to obtain given tension.

Tension: 20 sts = 10 cm ridges (slightly stretched)

One skein project:

The pattern is flexible and can be worked in smaller or wider sections of ridges and eyelets. See photo and arrange sections of your own choice. It is advisable to end work with a section of ridges.

Pattern:

Sections of ridges and sections of eyelets. Work alternately approx.

5 - 7 ridges (= k 10 - 14 rows)and

7 - 9 rows of eyelets.

1 ridge = k 2 rows.

In beginning and end of work there is 1 row of eyelets between ridge sections.

Work in this manner:

Cast on 3 sts and k 1st row.

Increase at center:

2nd row: k1, 1yo (= inc 1 st), k1 (= center st), 1 yo (= inc 1 st), k1

Cont inc every row at each side of center st in this manner:

1yo before and 1yo after center st.

K all yo on following row.

Increase at ridges:

Inc 1 st in first st (= k1, k1 tbl) at beg of every row of ridges

Pattern: Work sections of ridges and eyelets as explained throughout work and inc at each side of center st throughout work and at beg of every row of ridges as explained.

Cast off:

Cast off very loosely.

With rem yarn make 3 small tassels and fasten to each corner.

Blocking:

shawl.

Stretch and pin work on ironing board according to measures (see sketch). Use steam iron and steam only (do not press). Flatten by hand and unpin when cold. Stretch and pin one section at the time if ironing board is too small for the entire
