BELLA BERET, MITTS & NECK SET

Patterns 1016, 1017, 1018

Finished measurements

Neck/Shoulder Warner #1018: Bottom circumference: 44 in/ 112 cm Length: 14.5 in/ 37 cm

Hat #1016: Brim circumference: approx 18 in/ 45.5 cm

Mittens #1017: Hand circumference: 8.25 in/ 21 cm Length: 10.25 in/ 26 cm

Yarn

You can use any Misti Alpaca Worsted Weight yarn:

Misti Alpaca Tonos Worsted (50% baby alpaca/ 50% merino wool, 100 g = approx 218 yards)

Misti Alpaca Qolla Worsted (20% baby alpaca/ 80% fine merino wool, 100 g = approx 218 yards)

Misti Alpaca Best of Nature Worsted (100% baby alpaca, 100 g = approx 218 yards)

Misti Alpaca Best of Nature Hand Painted Worsted (100% baby alpaca, 100 g = approx 218 yards)

Misti Alpaca Worsted (100% baby alpaca, 50 g = approx 109 yards; use twice the number of hanks of this yarn)

Shown in Tonos Worsted TW22 Sangria; felted set shown in Tonos Worsted TW12 Impossiblue

Neck Warmer: 2 hanks (200 grams total)

Beret: 2 hanks (200 grams total)

Mittens: 1 hank (100 grams total)

Needles

US 6 = 4 mm, 16 in/40cm and 24 in/ 60 cm circular, and set of 5 double-pointed needles, or size necessary to obtain gauge

US 2.5 = 3 mm, 16 in/ 40 cm circular or set of 5 double-pointed needles

Notions

Stitch marker
Waste yarn for mittens

Gauge/Tension

Neck/shoulder warmer: 26 sts and 29 rows = 10 cm or 4 in in k4, p2 rib on larger needles

Hat/mittens: 22 sts and approx 28 rows = 10 cm or 4 in in St st on larger needles

Felted hat #1033 and mittens #1032: Needles

US 7 = 4.5 mm 16 in/40 cm and 24 in/ 60 cm circular, and set of 5 double-pointed needles, or size necessary to obtain gauge

US 6 = 4 mm, 16 in/ 40 cm circular or set of 5 double-pointed needles

Notions

Stitch marker
Waste yarn for mittens

Gauge/Tension

20 sts and approx 24 rows = 10 cm or 4 in in St st on larger needles before felting



FELTED HAT & MITTENS

Patterns 1032 & 1033

Knitting Notest

To make the felted beret and mittens, follow the same instruction as the non-felted beret and mittens, using the larger size needles.

Felt the finished items by hand, shaping pieces to size while still wet. Place some newspaper inside the mittens while drying, and crumpled newspaper inside the beret.

Edging

Rnds 1 and 3: Purl.

Rnds 2 and 4: Knit.

Rnd 5: *K2tog, yo; rep from * around.

Rnds 6 and 8: Rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 7: Rep Rnd 1.

Rnd 9: Rep Rnd 5.

Rnds 10 and 12: Knit.

Pattern Stitches

Cable cast-on: *Insert right needle between next 2 sts on left needle, yarn over and draw through a stitch and place on left needle. Repeat from * until the required number of stitches have been cast on.

ssk: slip 2 stitches knitwise, one at a time, to right needle, place the 2 slipped stitches back onto left needle, and knit them together through the back of the loops.

To knit

Neck/shoulder Warmer

With shorter size US 6 (4 mm) circular or dpns, loosely CO 90 sts. Pm for beg of rnd. Join to work in rnds. Cont in k4, p2 rib until work meas 7.5 in/ 19 cm.

Next (inc) rnd: *K4, p1, M1, p1; rep from * around = 105 sts. Work 3 rnds of k4, p3 rib.

Next (inc) rnd: *K4, p2, M1, p1; rep from * around = 120 sts. Rep inc rnd every 4 rnds 5 more times, working inc at approx center of each purl section, and purling new sts = 195 sts. Cont even until work meas 12.75 in/ 32.5 cm and inc 5 sts evenly spaced around last rnd = 200 sts.





BELLA HAT, MITTS & NECK SET

Patterns 1016, 1017, 1018

Rnds 11 and 13: Purl.
Rnd 14: Working kwise, BO 1 st, *place rem st on RH needle back on LH needle, using cable method, CO 2 new sts, BO 4 sts; rep from * around, fasten off rem st.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements if desired.

Mittens:

Right Hand: With larger dpns, CO 44 sts. Divide sts evenly over 4 needles. Pm for beg of rnd. Join to work in rnds. Cont in St st until work meas .75 in/ 2 cm.

Thumb gusset: Next (inc) rnd: K23, pm, M1, k1, M1, pm, knit to end = 46 sts. Work 2 rnds even.

Next (inc) rnd: K23, sm, M1, knit to marker, M1, sm, knit to end = 48 sts. Rep last 3 rnds 3 more times = 54 sts, and 11 sts between markers. Work 2 rnds even. Next rnd: Knit to marker, place 11 thumb sts on piece of waste yarn, CO 5 sts over gap, knit to end = 48 sts. Redistribute sts evenly over 4 needles. Cont even until work meas approx 3.75 in/ 9.5 cm from thumb opening, or approx 1.5 in/ 4 cm from desired length.

Shape top: Next (dec) rnd: K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts on needle 2, ssk, k2, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts on needle 4, ssk, k1 = 44 sts. Rep last rnd 9 more times = 8 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving an 8 in/ 20.5 cm tail. Th read tail through rem sts and fasten securely on WS.

Thumb: Place 11 thumb sts on dpns, pick up and k3 sts along CO sts above opening and 1 st at each end of opening = 16 sts. Pm for beg of rnd. Join to work in rnds.

Work St st until thumb meas approx 2.25 in/ 5.5 cm, or desired length.

Next (dec) rnd: *K2tog; rep from * around = 8 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving an 8 in/ 20.5 cm tail. Th read tail through rem sts and fasten securely on WS.

Cuf

With smaller dpns, pick up and k44 sts along CO edge. Pm for beg of rnd. Join to work in rnds. Rnds 1 and 3: Purl.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 4: *K2tog, yo; rep from * around.

Rnd 5: Knit.

Rnd 6: Purl.

Rnd 7: Knit and inc 4 sts evenly spaced around = 48 sts.

Rnds 8-17: Rep Rnds 3-7 twice more = 56 sts.

Rnds 18-22: Rep Rnds 3-7 once more, omitting inc on last rnd.

Rnd 23: Purl.

Rnd 24: Working kwise, BO 1 st, *place rem st on RH needle back on LH needle, using cable method, CO 2 new sts, BO 4 sts; rep from * around, fasten off rem st.

Left Hand

With larger dpns, CO 44 sts. Divide sts evenly over 4 needles. Pm for beg of rnd. Join to work in rnds. Cont in St st until work meas .75 in/ 2 cm.

Thumb gusset

Next (inc) rnd: K20, pm, M1, k1, M1, pm, knit to end = 46 sts. Work 2 rnds even.

Next (inc) rnd: K20, sm, M1, knit to marker, M1, sm, knit to end = 48 sts. Complete left mitten same as right.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.

Beret

With shorter size US 6 (4 mm) circular needles, CO 106 sts. Pm for beg of rnd. Join to work in rnds.

Work 2 rnds in St st.

Next (inc) rnd: K9, *M1, k8; rep from * 11 more times, k1 = 118 sts. Work 4 rnds even.

Next (inc) rnd: K5, *M1, k9; rep from * 11 more



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times, k5 = 130 sts. Work 4 rnds even.
Next (inc) rnd: *K10, M1; rep from * 11 more times, k10 = 142 sts.
Rep inc rnd every 5 rnds twice more, alternating placement of inc and with 1 more st between inc each time = 166 sts.
Work 6 rnds even.

Shape top

Next (dec) rnd: K6, *k2tog, k14; rep from * 9 more times = 156 sts. Work 4 rnds even.
Next (dec) rnd: *K2tog, k11; rep from * 11 more times = 144 sts. Work 4 rnds even.
Next (dec) rnd: K6, *k2tog, k10; rep from * 10 more times, k2tog, knit to end = 132 sts. Work 4 rnds even.
Next (dec) rnd: *K2tog, k9; rep from * 11 more times = 120 sts. Work 2 rnds even.
Rep dec rnd on next rnd, then every other rnd 8 more times, alternating placement of dec and with 1 fewer st between dec each time = 12 sts rem.
Cut yarn, leaving an 8 in/ 20.5 cm tail.
Th read tail through rem sts and fasten securely on WS.

Edging

With shorter size US 2.5 (3 mm) circular needles or dpns and RS facing, pick up and k106 sts along CO edge. Pm for beg of rnd. Join to work in rnds.
Rnds 1 and 3: Purl.
Rnd 2: Knit.
Rnd 4: *K2tog, yo; rep from * around.
Rnd 5: Knit.
Rnds 6-13: Rep Rnds 1-5 once, then Rnds 1-3 again.
Rnd 14: Working kwise, BO 1 st, *place rem st on RH needle back on LH needle, using cable method, CO 2 new sts, BO 4 sts; rep from * around, fasten off rem st.

Finishing

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements if desired.
